

CHAPTER LXXXVII.

An Act to authorize the Trustees of School District No. 1, in Steele County, to raise money for certain purposes.

- SECTION 1. Authority to levy a tax for the erection of School Buildings.
2. Act takes effect on passage.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Tax levy for school building SECTION 1. That School District number one in Steele County, is hereby authorized to levy a tax upon the taxable property of said district of an amount not exceeding twenty-five hundred dollars, for the purpose of erecting a school house for said district, said tax to be collected according to the provisions of existing laws on this subject. *Provided*, That if the said district shall choose to do so, it is hereby authorized to borrow money to the above amount on the faith and credit of the district, and for the purposes above stated.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXXXVIII.

An Act to amend an Act entitled "An Act to Incorporate the Little Falls Manufacturing Company".

- SECTION 1. Amendment to Sec. 2. Business of Company, how designated—
Management of affairs by Directors.
2. Act takes effect on passage.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That Section two of the Act entitled "An Act

to Incorporate the Little Falls Manufacturing Company," approved March 1st, 1856, be amended so as to read as follows; Business how designated—

Section 2. The business of said company shall be defined by management of affairs the by-laws thereof, and may extend to the manufacture of flour, lumber, and of any and all articles which said company may deem proper, and shall be conducted under the management and supervision of a board of five directors, to be elected by the said corporators and their successors, in such manner and at such times, and shall perform such duties as may be prescribed by the laws of said company. Said Directors shall choose a President, Secretary, and such other officers as the by-laws of said company may prescribe. The President shall in all cases be one of the number of said directors.

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXXXIX.

An Act to protect Fish in Green Lake in Chisago County.

- SECTION 1. Fishing by sein or net in Green Lake is prohibited.
2. Penalty for violation of this Act.
3. Suits may be commenced by parties having knowledge of violation.
4. Act takes effect after September 1, 1858.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That all persons are hereby forbid to take any Fish out of the waters of Green Lake in Chisago County, with sein or net. Fishing in Green Lake prohibited—penalty

Sec. 2. That any and all persons upon being convicted of a violation of the provisions of this Act, shall pay a fine of not more than twenty-five (25) dollars nor less than five
