An Act to regulate the Fees of Clerks of District Courts.

- SECTION 1. Amendment of Section two of Chapter seventy-three of the Revised Statutes, relative to fees of Clerk of District Court.
 - 2. Repeal of portion of said Section allowing per diem of five dollars.
 - 3. Act to take effect immediately.

Be it enacted by the Legisleture of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That Section two (2) Chapter sixty-three (63) of the Compiled Statutes. the same being Section two (2) Chapter seventy-three (73) of the Revised Statutes, be, and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

Provided, That the gross amount of fees of any Clerk of the District Court shall in no case exceed the following sums:

In case of a judgment by cognovit or confession, two (2) Frees of Clerk of dollars. District Court

In any case where there is no appearance of the defendant, two (2) dollars.

In any other case, six (6) dollars.

SEC. 2. That so much of the above mentioned Section as Repeal of law al- allows said Clerk of Court a per diam of five dollars, for towing a per diem attendance on court. the same being that portion of Section of $\{k\}$ the first dollars of the Fourier defined Section of the first dollars.
