

CHAPTER LXXIII.

An Act to prescribe the number of Members who shall compose the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Minnesota, and to Apportion the Representation in both Houses, throughout the different sections of the State.

- SECTION 1. Number of members of Senate and House of Representatives.
 2. Apportionment of Districts.
 3. Act to take effect on passage.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Number of mem- SECTION 1. That for the next Legislature, and thereafter
 bers of House until a new apportionment shall have been made, the Senate of
 and Senate the State shall be composed of twenty-one (21) members, and
 the House of Representatives shall be composed of forty-two
 (42) members.

Apportionment of Districts SEC. 2. That the representation in the Senate and House
 of Representatives be apportioned throughout the State in
 twenty-one Senatorial and Representative Districts, as follows,
 to wit:

1-1 Senator, 2 The first District shall be composed of the First and Second
 Representatives 3 Wards in the city of St. Paul, and the Townships of McLean,
 New Canada, White Bear and Mount View, in Ramsey county
 and shall be entitled to elect one (1) Senator and two (2)
 Representatives.

2-1 Senator, 3 The Second District shall be composed of the counties of
 Representatives 3 Washington, Chisago, Pine and Kanabec, and shall be entitled
 to elect one (1) Senator and three (3) Representatives.

1-1 Senator, 3 The Third District shall be composed of the counties of
 Representatives 3 Stearns, Todd, Cass, Wadena, Otter Tail, Tombs, Breckenridge,
 Douglas, Becker, Polk, Pembina, Morrison, Crow Wing,
 Aiken, Itaska, Buchanan, Carlton, St. Louis and Lako, and
 shall be entitled to elect one (1) Senator and three (3) Represent-
 tives.

1-1 Senator, 3 The Fourth District shall be composed of that part of Hen-
 Representatives 3 nepin county which lies on the east side of the Mississippi
 river, and the counties of Manomin, Anoka, Sherburne, Benton,
 Isanti and Mille Lac, and shall be entitled to elect one (1)
 Senator and two (2) Representatives.

1-1 Senator, 2 The Fifth District shall be composed of that portion of
 Representatives 2 Hennepin county which lies on the west side of the Missis-
 sippi river, and shall be entitled to elect one (1) Senator and
 two (2) Representatives.

The Sixth District shall be composed of the counties of ^{6-1 Senator, 2} Carver, Wright, Meeker, McLeod, Kandiyohi and Monongalia, ^{Representatives} and shall be entitled to elect one (1) Senator and three (3) Representatives.

The Seventh District shall be composed of the county of ^{7-1 Senator, 2} Dakota, and shall be entitled to elect one (1) Senator and two ^{Representatives} (2) Representatives.

The Eighth District shall be composed of the county of ^{8-1 Senator, 2} Rice, and shall be entitled to elect one (1) Senator and two ^{Representatives} (2) Representatives.

The Ninth District shall be composed of the county of ^{9-1 Senator, 2} Goodhue, and shall be entitled to elect one (1) Senator and ^{Representatives} two (2) Representatives.

The Tenth District shall be composed of the county of ^{10-1 Senator, 1} Wabashaw and shall be entitled to elect one (1) Senator and ^{Representative} one (1) Representative.

The Eleventh District shall be composed of the county of ^{11-1 Senator, 2} Winona, and shall be entitled to elect one (1) Senator and two ^{Representatives} (2) Representatives.

The Twelfth District shall be composed of the county of ^{12-1 Senator, 2} Olmsted, and shall be entitled to elect one (1) Senator and ^{Representatives} two (2) Representatives.

The Thirteenth District shall be composed of the county of ^{13-1 Senator, 1} Houston, and shall be entitled to elect one (1) Senator and one ^{Representative} (1) Representative.

The Fourteenth District shall be composed of the county of ^{14-1 Senator, 3} Fillmore, and shall be entitled to elect one (1) Senator and ^{Representatives} three (3) Representatives.

The Fifteenth District shall be composed of the counties ^{15-1 Senator, 2} of Mower and Dodge, and shall be entitled to elect one (1) ^{Representatives} Senator and two (2) Representatives.

The Sixteenth District shall be composed of the counties of ^{16-1 Senator, 2} Steele, Waseca and Freeborn, and shall be entitled to elect ^{Representatives} one (1) Senator and two (2) Representatives.

The Seventeenth District shall be composed of the counties ^{17-1 Senator, 3} of Blue Earth and Le Sueur, and shall be entitled to elect one ^{Representatives} (1) Senator and three (3) Representatives.

The Eighteenth District shall be composed of the county of ^{18-1 Senator, 1} Scott, and shall be entitled to elect one (1) Senator and one ^{Representative} (1) Representative.

The Nineteenth District shall be composed of the counties ^{19-1 Senator, 2} of Nicollet, Sibley, Renville, Pierce, Davis, and that portion ^{Representatives} of Brown county which lies west of Range thirty-three (33), and shall be entitled to elect one (1) Senator and two (2) Representatives.

The Twentieth District shall be composed of the counties ^{20-1 Senator, 1} of Faribault, Martin, Jackson, Cottonwood, Murray, Nobles, ^{Representative} Pipestone, Rock, and that portion of Brown county which lies east of Range thirty-four (34), and shall be entitled to elect one (1) Senator and one (1) Representative.

21—1 Senator, 1 Representative The Twenty-first District shall be composed of the Third and Fourth Wards in the city of St. Paul, and Reserve and Rose Townships in the county of Ramsey, and shall be entitled to elect one (1) Senator and one (1) Representative.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXXIV.

An Act to amend an act entitled "An Act to regulate corporations for Manufacturing, Mining, Agricultural, Mechanical and Chemical purposes," passed August twelfth, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight.

SECTION 1. Add Sec. 23. Adoption of Sections 11, 12, 13, and 14 into the charter of corporations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That said act is hereby amended by adding thereto the following Section :

SEC. 23. Any corporation created before the passage of this Act, may, by a vote of a majority of its stockholders, adopt Sections eleven (11), twelve (12), thirteen (13) and fourteen (14), or either of them, as a part of its charter, and thereupon, the Section or Sections of this Act, so adopted, shall be a part of the charter of said corporation; *Provided*, That such adoption and amendment shall not operate to extend the liability of
