CHAPTER XCVII.

An Act to amend an act entitled, "An Act to provide for the government of the State Prison of the State of Minnesota," passed August second, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight.

SECTION 1. Amend Sec. 18 of act passed August 2nd, 1858. Salary of Warden and other officers of State Prison.

2. Act to take effect on passage.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That Section eighteen (18) of said act be so amended as to read :

SEC. 18. There shall be paid to the Warden of the Prison an annual salary of seven hundred and fifty (750) dollars, to be paid quarterly out of the State Treasury upon salary of Warthe warrants of the Auditor, and who shall discharge and perden and other form all the duties hitherto devolving upon the Warden, Depofficers uty Warden and Clerk. And to the Physician, Assistant Keeper, and Guards, such sum as may be deemed just and proper by the inspectors of said prison to be paid in the same manner as provided for the Warden, upon the certificates of the said inspectors.

 \hat{S}_{EC} . 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
