

CHAPTER XIV.

An Act to Legalize the Sale of Lands for Delinquent Taxes in the County of Wasoca.

SECTION 1. Sale of lands for taxes in the year 1859, legalized.
 2. When to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sale of lands for taxes by the County Treasurer of Waseca County, in the year eighteen hundred and fifty-nine is hereby legalized and declared to be as binding as if such lands had been sold at the time prescribed by law. Sale of lands for taxes legalized.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.


