

CHAPTER XXI.

An Act Authorizing the Register of Deeds of Sherburne County to sell the Lands in said County Returned in the Delinquent Tax List of the year eighteen hundred and fifty-seven.

SECTION 1. Register of Deeds to advertise lands.
2. When Act takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Register to advertise lands.

SECTION 1. The Register of Deeds of Sherburne County is hereby required to advertise all lands in said county returned for the delinquent taxes of the year eighteen hundred and fifty seven, and sell the same on the first Monday of May next, and the next succeeding days; and all sales made in pursuance of this act, shall conform in all respects to, and be valid and binding as like sales made in accordance with the provisions of law in force on the first day of January, A. D. eighteen hundred and fifty eight.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XXII.

An Act to prevent the destruction of fish in the Lakes of the County of Ramsey, in this State.

SECTION 1. Fishing in a certain way forbidden.
2. Fines for violation.
3. When Act takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That it shall not be lawful for any person or

persons to fish with seines, nets or traps in any of the Lakes within the said County of Ramsey, in this State. Fishing, in a certain way, prohibited

SEC. 2. That any person or persons who may violate the provisions of the first section of this Act shall be deemed to be guilty of a malicious trespass, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not less than five dollars, nor more than twenty-five dollars; and for a second offence, shall incur a penalty not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty dollars; *Provided*, That no penalty shall be incurred for taking fish from lakes owned by such persons respectively. Fines.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XXIII.

An Act to authorize the City Council of Hastings to appropriate money for the erection of County Buildings.

- SECTION 1. Power to appropriate money.
2. Payment of interest.
3. Power to hypothecate.
4. A vote before bonds issue.
5. When Act takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The Council of the City of Hastings in the County of Dakota in the State of Minnesota, are hereby empowered to appropriate from any funds in the Treasury of said City, any sum not exceeding Five Thousand Dollars, to the use of said County of Dakota, to be applied towards erecting and constructing a Court House, Jail and other County buildings, within the limits of said City; and in case Power to appropriate five thousand dollars.
