

## CHAPTER XXXIV.

*An Act to provide for the organization and to define the boundaries of Todd County.***SECTION 1. Boundaries defined.**

1. County Seat
2. Commissioners appointed; their powers.
3. Commissioners to post notices of submission of removal of County Seat, and for the election of officers.
4. Commissioners to cause notice of removal to be published.
5. Terms of office of Commissioners.
6. Boundaries submitted to a vote of the electors in the counties interested.
7. Conflicting Acts repealed.
8. When Act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the boundaries of Todd County be and the same are hereby established as follows, to wit: Beginning at a point in the Mississippi river opposite the mouth of Platte river, running west to the range line between ranges thirty-five and thirty-six west of fifth principal meridian; thence north on said range line between ranges thirty-five and thirty-six to the corner of towns one hundred and thirty-three and one hundred and thirty-four north to its intersection with the left bank of Crow Wing river, thence along the left bank of Crow Wing river to its junction with the Mississippi, thence down the channel of the Mississippi to the place of beginning. Boundaries.

SEC. 2. That the County-seat of said County shall be temporarily located at Long Prairie, and there remain until removed in accordance with the provisions of this Act. County Seat.

SEC. 3. That the Governor shall appoint and commission three suitable persons, the same being qualified voters of said county, with full power and authority to do and perform all acts and duties devolving upon the Board of County Commissioners of any organized County of this State, and the said commissioners shall have full power to appoint all officers necessary to the complete organization of said county. Governor to appoint Commissioners.

SEC. 4. And it shall be the duty of the said commissioners to post or cause to be posted notices at the several precincts in said County at least twenty days before the election holden in April next, declaring that the removal of the County-seat of said County to Elk City, in said County, will be submitted to the voters thereof on the day of said election in April, and also that all officers necessary for the organization of said county, will, on such day of election be voted for, together with such other matter as it may be necessary for the voters of said County to act upon. Vote on the removal of County Seat.  
Election of officers.

**Notice of removal** SEC. 5. That if it shall appear that a majority of the votes cast at the April election are for the removal of the County seat, then it shall be the duty of the County Commissioners to cause a notice of such removal to be published in a weekly paper in this State, for at least four weeks.

**Terms of office.** SEC. 6. And the said commissioners and officers so appointed, as provided in section three of this Act, shall hold their terms of office respectively, until their successors are elected and qualified according to law.

**Boundaries submitted to a vote.** SEC. 7. That so much of this Act as effects the boundaries of said County, shall be submitted to the citizens of the counties affected thereby, at the next general election, for their approval or rejection; and if a majority voting thereon shall confirm this Act, the boundaries shall be as herein defined.

**Repealing clause.** SEC. 8. That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act, be, and the same are hereby repealed.

SEC. 9. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

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## CHAPTER XXXV.

### *An Act amending an act entitled "An Act Incorporating the Town of Chatfield."*

SECTION 1. Amends section eleven of Act of Incorporation.  
2. When to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. Section eleven (11) of an act entitled "an Act incorporating the Town of Chatfield" is hereby amended by adding thereto as follows:

"*Seventeenth.* Whenever said Town Council shall deem it necessary to construct or repair any sidewalk within the Town, they shall direct the owners or occupants of any lot
