CHAPTER XLIV.

An Act to legalize certain taxes and tax sales for the benefit of School District number one, in the Town of Furibault.

SECTION 1: Legalizes School Tax for eighteen hundred and fifty-zeven,
2. Legalizes School Tax for eighteen hundred and fifty-eight.
3. When Act takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The tax levied by School District number one, Legalizes School in Rice Coupty, on the twenty-sixth day of September, one Tax for eighteen thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven, the sale of lands therefor, together with all proceedings relating to such tax and sale are hereby legalized, ratified and confirmed.

SEC. 2. The tax levied by said school district on the twenty-fifth day of September, one thousand eight hundred fluoring and fifty-eight, and all proceedings relating thereto, are hereby legalized, ratified and confirmed, and the Clerk of the said district to whom said tax was committed for collection, or his successor in office, is hereby authorized and required to return the unpaid portion of said tax to the County Treasurer as delinquent, and thereupon said County County Treasurer Treasurer shall proceed to sell the land so returned, as in to sell for delinor other cases, at any time before the first day of July next.

Sec. 3. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
