CHAPTER XLIX.

An Act to change the time of holding the Terms of the District Court in the Fifth Judicial District.

SECTION 1. Terms of District Court of the Fifth Judicial District.
2. Repealing section.
3. Adapts judicial proceedings to the new terms.
4. When Act takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SEC. 1. The general terms of the District Courts in the Fifth Judicial District shall be held at the times and places following:

Writs, &c., re-turnable at new

terms.

In the county of Waseca, on the first Monday of March Waseca County. and first Monday of September of each year.

In the county of Dodge, on the second Monday of March Dodge County. and the second Monday of September of each year.

In the county of Mower, on the third Monday of March of Mower County.

each year. In the county of Freeborn, on the fourth Monday of March Freeborn County.

and the fourth Monday of September of each year. In the county of Rice, on the first Monday of April and Rice County. the first Monday of October of each year.

In the county of Scott, on the third Monday of April and Scott County. the third Monday of October of each year.

In the county of Steele, on the first Monday of May and Steele County. the first Monday of December of each year,

SEC. 2. The fifth subdivision of section one, of an act Repealing section entitled "An Act to establish the terms of the District Court of the State of Minnesota," on page one hundred and fifty-six of the Session Laws of A. D. eighteen hundred and fiftyeight, being also contained on page four hundred and eightyfour of the Public Statutes, is hereby repealed.

All writs, recognizances, and other proceedings made returnable to the District Court of any of said counties, shall be considered and deemed to be returnable to the terms of such Court as are fixed by this act, and all continuances and notices made or taken to any term of the District Court of any of said counties, shall be deemed to be made or taken to the terms of such Court as the same are fixed by this act, and all motions and other proceedings noticed to be heard at any regular term of such Court, shall be allowed and considered to be noticed for hearing at the regular terms of such Court, as the same are fixed by this act.

This act shall take effect and be in force from and Sec. 4.

after its passage.
