

## CHAPTER VI.

*An Act for the relief of School District number six in Houston County.*

- SECTION 1. Authorizes School Trustees to issue warrant to collect certain delinquent school taxes.  
 2. Clerk authorized to collect.  
 3. When to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

Trustees to issue warrant for collection of taxes. SEC. 1. The Trustees of School District number six, in the County of Houston, or their successors in office, are hereby authorized and required to issue their warrant to the Clerk of said district, or his successor in office, in the form prescribed by law, authorizing and directing him to proceed to collect, according to law, certain school taxes in said school district, which were authorized by a vote of the legal voters of said district, for the purpose of building a school house and for other necessary contingent expenses in said district in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty-eight, or so much thereof as remain delinquent and unpaid.

Duty of Clerk to collect tax. Validity of warrant. SEC. 2. The Clerk of said school district, or his successor in office, is hereby authorized to proceed to collect said taxes under and by virtue of said warrant, in the same manner and with the same effect as if the same had been issued within the time prescribed by law, and said warrant is hereby declared to be as valid and of the same force as if the same had been issued within the time prescribed by law and no other warrant had been issued for the collection of said taxes.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
