whole expense thereof, and the lots chargeable with the expense, and the owner's name, if known, and the proportion of the expense to be assessed to each lot; and, in the case of grading a street or alley, a proper grade; and the Common Council may adopt, revise, correct, or remand the same with instructions. Upon such report being adopted, an Survey and profile accurate survey and profile of such grade shall be prepared by the City Surveyor, and filed in his office of record. The Common Council may thereupon order the said work to be placed under contract, upon such terms and under such regulations as they may deem advisable.
