CHAPTER LXXIV.

An Act to re-locate certain State Roads in Mower County.

SECTION 1. Appoints Commissioners. 2. Meeting.

3. Expenses. When Act takes effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That J. E. Willard, V. P. Lewis, and J. F. Cook, are hereby appointed commissioners to re-locate that Commissioners. portion of the Mankato and Austin, and the Wabashaw and Austin, also the Austin and Saint Paul State roads, in sections twenty-two and twenty-seven, of town one hundred and three, range eighteen west, so that said roads shall conform to the location of the Iowa line and Saint Paul State road.

Sec. 2. Said commissioners shall meet at the town of Lansing, in Mower county, on or before the first Monday of Mosting. June, A. D. eighteen hundred and sixty, and proceed to discharge the duties imposed upon them by the provisions of this act, provided; however, that in case of absence of any one of said commissioners at the time designated by a majority of them to meet, a majority of said commissioners shall proceed to discharge the duties required by this act.

SEC. 3. All expenses incurred by the re-location of said Expenses. road shall be paid by persons interested in the same.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
