An Act in Relation to Entering and Recording the Satisfaction of Mortgages.

SECTION 1. Duty of Register of Deeds, 2. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That whenever any mortgage or con-Duty of Register ditional conveyance shall be discharged or released by an entry on the margin of the record thereof, it shall be the duty of the register of deeds to make an entry of such release or discharge in his reception book, as of the reception of an instrument of release or discharge, which entry shall refer definitely to the mortgage or conditional conveyance so released or discharged.

> SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first day of May next.
