

CHAPTER LXII.

An Act making an Appropriation for the Purposes therein named.

SECTION 1. Appropriation to pay S. M. Flint for services rendered in 1858.
 2. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The sum of twenty-seven dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to pay S. M. Flint for services rendered the State at the request of the Hon. Aaron Goodrich, commissioner, in reading proof of the report on pleadings and practice, and comparing a revision to the general laws of the State in the year eighteen hundred and fifty-eight.

CHAPTER LXIII.

An Act making an Appropriation for the Incidental Printing.

SECTION 1. Appropriation for the incidental printing for present session of the Legislature.
 2. Duty of State Auditor.
 3. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated to William R. Marshall, in payment to him for executing

the incidental printing, binding, and publication of the laws in the Saint Paul Press, for the present session of the Legislature, the sum of five thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Duty of State
Auditor

SEC. 2. It is hereby made the duty of the Auditor of State to audit all bills for said printing, binding and publication, as the same or any portion thereof may be completed and delivered, at the prices provided for in the contract made by the committee on printing of the senate and house of representatives with said William R. Marshall, and to draw his warrant upon the Treasurer of State for the payment of the same.

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXIV.

An Act making Appropriations for Expenses of Andrew Nessel and J. P. Kidder in Contested Election Cases.

SECTION 1. Appropriation for reimbursing Andrew Nessel and J. P. Kidder in contested election case.

2. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money be and the same are hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated:

For contested

First, To Andrew Nessel for the purpose of reimbursing said Nessel, moneys by him expended in paying justices, witnesses, and other officers in the case of *Nessel vs. Kidder*, fifty dollars (\$50).
