### Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That A. D. Brown, G. White and Robert Reed are hereby appointed commissioners, to mark out commissioners appointed and locate a State road, commencing at the north terminus of Mill street in the village of Brownsdale in Mower county, and thence by the nearest and most practicable route to a point of intersection with the La Orosse and Mankato State road in said county.

SEC. 2. That said commissioners shall meet at the village of Brownsdale, on or before the fifteenth day of Meeting of com-October, A. ### Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SEC. 1. That Charles A. Gillman, William Smith and Adolph Munch be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners to locate and mark a State road, commencing at Sauk Rapids in Benton county, and from thence on the most direct and feasible route to intersect the road located from St. Paul on the south side of Snake River to Lake Superior, at such point as the said commissioners may deem best.

SEO. 2. That said commissioners shall meet at Sauk Rapids, on the first of October next, and in case any of the commissioners appointed by this Act neglect or refuse to act as provided by this Act, the others shall appoint some reliable person or persons to till such vacancy. SEC. 3. That at the first meeting of said commissioners, they shall designate the time when they will commence the laying out said road, and may adjourn from

time to time as may in their opinion be necessary.
