

SEC. 5. That said commissioners shall cause to be filed and deposited in the office of register of deeds of the counties through which the said road may pass, a copy of the plat, an exemplification of which shall be legal evidence of the opening and existence of said road. To file plat of road

SEC. 6. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. Act, when to take effect

## CHAPTER XIV.

*An Act to Provide for the Location of a State Road from Brownsdale in Mower County, to a point of intersection with the La Crosse and Mankato State Road in said County.*

- SECTION 1. Commissioners appointed.  
 2. Meeting of Commissioners—when to fill vacancies.  
 3. Deposit draft of said road.  
 4. Who not to pay expenses of location of said road.  
 5. Act—when to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That A. D. Brown, G. White and Robert Reed are hereby appointed commissioners, to mark out and locate a State road, commencing at the north terminus of Mill street in the village of Brownsdale in Mower county, and thence by the nearest and most practicable route to a point of intersection with the La Crosse and Mankato State road in said county. Commissioners appointed

SEC. 2. That said commissioners shall meet at the village of Brownsdale, on or before the fifteenth day of October, A. D. 1861, and proceed to discharge the duties imposed upon them by the provisions of this Act; Meeting of commissioners—when to fill vacancy *Provided*, That in the absence of any one of said commissioners, the others may supply said vacancy by appointing another commissioner, or, in case a majority of them meet, may proceed to discharge their duties.

SEC. 3. That said commissioners shall make a fair

Deposit draft of said road and accurate draft of the location of the road, a copy of which shall be deposited with the register of deeds of said county.

Who not to pay expenses of location of said road SEC. 4. That neither the State of Minnesota, the county of Mower or any town through which the located line of road may pass, shall ever be liable for any expense whatever, accruing from the location of said road.

Act, when to take effect SEC. 5. This Act shall take effect from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER XV.

### *An Act to Provide for Laying out a State Road from Sauk Rapids to Fortuna.*

- SECTION 1. Commissioners appointed.  
 2. When and where to meet—to fill vacancies.  
 3. To designate when to begin operations.  
 4. Expenses to be paid by the counties through which said road passes.  
 5. Act—when to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

Commissioners appointed SEC. 1. That Charles A. Gillman, William Smith and Adolph Munch be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners to locate and mark a State road, commencing at Sauk Rapids in Benton county, and from thence on the most direct and feasible route to intersect the road located from St. Paul on the south side of Snake River to Lake Superior, at such point as the said commissioners may deem best.

When and where to meet—to fill vacancies SEC. 2. That said commissioners shall meet at Sauk Rapids, on the first of October next, and in case any of the commissioners appointed by this Act neglect or refuse to act as provided by this Act, the others shall appoint some reliable person or persons to fill such vacancy.

To designate when to begin operations SEC. 3. That at the first meeting of said commissioners, they shall designate the time when they will commence the laying out said road, and may adjourn from time to time as may in their opinion be necessary.
