

CHAPTER XXIII.

An Act to Define the Boundaries of Meeker County.

- SECTION 1. Boundary lines established and defined.
 2. All other acts relating to same, repealed.
 3. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Boundary lines
 established and
 defined

SEC. 1. The following lines are established as the boundary lines of the county of Meeker: Beginning at the southeast corner of town one hundred and eighteen, (118) of range twenty-nine, (29) running thence in a westerly direction twenty-four (24) miles along the line between towns one hundred and seventeen (117) and one hundred and eighteen, (118) to the southwest corner of town one hundred and eighteen, of range thirty-two, thence in a northerly direction, along the range line between ranges thirty-two (32) and thirty-three, (33) to the northwest corner of town one hundred and twenty-one, (121) of range thirty-two, (32) thence in an easterly direction, along the town line between towns one hundred and twenty-one (121) and one hundred and twenty-two, (122) to the north-east corner of town one hundred and twenty-one (121) of range thirty, (30) thence in a southerly direction three miles, to the southwest corner of section eighteen, (18) of town one hundred and twenty-one (121) of range twenty-nine, (29) thence in an easterly direction along the section lines to the southeast corner of section thirteen (13) of town one hundred and twenty-one, (121) of range twenty-nine, (29) thence in a southerly direction along the line between ranges twenty-eight (28) and twenty-nine (29) to the place of beginning.

SEC. 2. All other acts or parts of acts in relation to the boundaries of the above named county heretofore passed, are hereby repealed.

Act, when to
 take effect

SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect from and after its provisions are adopted by a majority of the voters, voting in the counties affected thereby, at the next general election.
