

CHAPTER XXIV.

An Act to Change the Boundary Lines of Aiken County, and to Define the Same.

SECTION 1. Boundaries established and defined.
 2. Act, when to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The boundary lines of Aiken county shall be as follows: Beginning at the southeast corner of township forty-three of range twenty-two, thence north along the range line, between ranges twenty-one and twenty-two to the north-east corner of township forty-seven, of range twenty-two; thence west, along the correction line, between townships forty-seven and forty-eight to the Mississippi river; thence down the main channel of said river to the line between ranges twenty-seven and twenty-eight; thence south, along said last named range line to the south-west corner of township forty-four, of range twenty-seven; thence east, along the township line between townships forty-three and forty-four to the south-west corner of township forty-four, of range twenty-four; thence south, along the range line to the south-west corner of township forty-three, of range twenty-four; thence east, along the township line between townships forty-two and forty-three to the place of beginning.

Boundaries established and defined

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect on the proclamation of the Governor, of the adoption of the same by a majority of the electors of the counties of Pine and Ramsey, present and voting thereon at the next general election.
