### Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The boundary line between Scott and Da-Boundary dekota counties shall be as follows: Commencing at the food southeast corner of township one hundred and thirteen (113) north of range twenty-one (21) west, thence running west one and one-half miles on the south line of said township to the one-quarter  $(\frac{1}{2})$  post on the south line of

section thirty-five (35) in said township, thence running north on the one-quarter  $(\frac{1}{2})$  section line to the south line of township twenty-seven, (27) north of range twentyfour (24) west, thence west on township line to the southwest corner of section thirty-three (33) in said township twenty-seven, (27) thence north on section line to the middle of the channel of the Minnesota river.

SEC. 2. At the time of giving notice of the next election of members of the House of Representatives, it shall be the duty of the officers in Scott and Dakota counties required by law to give notice of such election, to give notice in like manner that at said election a vote will be taken on the question of changing the boundary Electors to vote line between said counties, in accordance with the provisions of this Act. The votes shall be canvassed in the same manner, and returned to the same officer, by judges of election of the several townships, as votes for members of the House of Representatives.
