egency for the State of Minnenote.

For medial mail routes, two or more mails are forwarded over the same route at an unnecessary expense.

That the expense, delay, and confusion now incident to the mail service would be greatly diminished by a more direct superintendence by the Government.

That the necessities of the inhabitants of the State imperatively demand a change in this particular.

Your memorialists would therefore, respectfully suggest and urge the appointment of a Special Mail Agent, for the State of Minnesota, or such other action on the part of the Government as will remedy and correct the existing abuse.

A Memorial to Congress for the establishment of a Mail route from St. Cloud in the State of Minnesota, to the city of Superior in the State of Wisconsin.

To the Honorable the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States, in Congress assembled :

The Legislature of the State of Minnesota would respectfully represent:

That the present mail facilities afforded to the people of Superior, are entirely insufficient to meet their wants. That the commercial interests connected with lake Superior, demand an increase of mail facilities; and

That the establishment of a mail route with semi-weekly service thereon from St. Cloud to Superior city, would , form one of the most important mail routes in this State.

Wherefore, your Memorialists, the Legislature of the State of Minnesota, most earnestly and respectfully ask that the mail route may be established as above specified and mail service ordered thereon.
