1. On account of State Prison, for year 1861.
 2. D. A. Robertson for boarding Michael Faux.
 3. D. A. Robertson for boarding Charles Burt and Christopher.
 4. John Grace for washing done for lunatics confined in Ramsey county jail.
 5. Strong & Wylie, for oil cloth for Governor's room.
 6. Wm. R. Marshall for printing Journals of Senate and House, and Laws of Extra session.
 7. Wm. R. Marshall, balance on bill printing Laws Extra session.
 8. Wm. R. Marshall, balance on bill for publishing Laws in St. Paul Press, Extra session.
 9. Clerk hire in Adjutant General's office, 1862.
 2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money are hereby appropriated, out of any money in the treasury, not otherwise appropriated:

First. For deficiencies due on account of State Prison, for incidental expenses for year ending December 1st, 1861, six hundred and ninety-five dollars and seventy-five cents, (\$695 75).

Second. To D. A. Robertson, for boarding, in the Ramsey county jail, Michael Faux, a lunatic, from Aug. 24th, 1862, to Dec. 31st, 1862, sixty dollars, (\$60).

Third. To D. A. Robertson, for boarding and safely keeping Charles Burt and Christopher, two lunatics, in

Ramsey county jail, from Nov. 15th to Dec. 1st, 1862, inclusive, twenty dollars, (\$20).

Fourth. To John Grace for washing done for lunatics confined in Ramsey county jail, ten dollars and fifty cents, (\$10 50).

Fifth. To Strong & Wylie, for oil cloth furnished for Governor's room, twenty-one dollars and fifty-eight cents, (\$21 58).

Sixth. To Wm. R. Marshall, for printing 300 copies each of Senate and House journals, and Executive documents for extra session of 1862, four hundred and seven dollars and thirty-nine cents, (\$407 39).

Seventh. To Wm. R. Marshall, for balance on bill for 5,000 copies general and special laws, extra session 1862, four hundred and eighty-one dollars and ninety-one cents, (\$481 91).

Eighth. To Wm. R. Marshall, for balance on bill for publishing laws of extra session, in St. Paul Press, one hundred and forty-two dollars and seventy cents, (\$142 70).

Ninth. For deficiency for clerk hire in Adjutant General's office, for the year 1862, ninety dollars, (\$90).

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
