

CHAPTER XXXIV.

An Act for the Relief of School District No. Thirty-Four (34), of Hennepin County.

SECTION 1. Tax may be levied in said district—for what purpose.
 2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That a tax of two hundred dollars levied by vote of school district No. thirty-four, in said county, upon the taxable property in said district for the tax year 1862, to pay the indebtedness of said district, contracted in building a school house therefor, be, and the same hereby is, declared to be a legal and binding tax upon said property, to be collected the same as other school district taxes for said year, the provisions of an act entitled "an act to provide for a general system of common schools, the officers thereof, and their respective duties and powers," approved March 8, 1862, to the contrary notwithstanding.

Tax may be levied in said district—for what purpose

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
