

CHAPTER XXXIX.

An Act to provide for the Apportionment of School Money in Meeker County, in 1862.

- SECTION 1. Duty of County Auditor.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Duty of County
Auditor

SECTION 1. The County Auditor of Meeker county is hereby authorized to apportion the school money in said Meeker county for A. D. 1862, according to the census of scholars in A. D. 1861.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
