

in the year 1858, by school district number one (1), of the town of Faribault, in the county of Rice, as the same appears upon the warrant issued for the collection of the same, bearing date November 15, 1858, are hereby legalized, so far as the same are not unconstitutional.

Legalization of delinquent school house tax for 1858

SEC. 2. Said delinquent school house taxes may be collected in the same manner, and by the same proceedings as any school house tax for the year 1863 might be collected under the laws now in force, by inserting the same in the tax duplicate for 1863.

How collected

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from the day of its passage.

CHAPTER XLI.

An Act to Provide for the Collection of a Special School Tax for the year 1862, in School District, number Thirty-Six, Dakota County.

- SECTION 1. Duty of County Auditor.
 2. Taxes to be legal and valid—duty of County Treasurer.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the County Auditor of the county of Dakota, be and he is hereby authorized and directed, on or before the first day of April, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, to extend on the tax duplicate of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, in said county, on the real estate in school district number thirty-six (36) in said county, the amount of tax which may have been voted by said district in conformity to law, to be raised for the year 1862.

Duty of County Auditor

Taxes to be legal
and valid—duty
of treasurer

SEC. 2. That said tax when extended on or against the real estate in said district shall be legal and valid, and the County Treasurer of said county shall have the same power to collect said tax by distress and sale as is now possessed by him in collecting county taxes.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

Approved, March 6, 1863.

CHAPTER XLII.

An Act to Repeal Chapter 44 of the Special Laws of 1862, relating to Free Schools in Minneapolis, and to confirm the Proceedings of the Board of Education of Minneapolis, and authorizing the filling of vacancies in said Board.

- SECTION 1. Repeal of former act.
2. Confirmation of proceedings of Board of Education.
3. Vacancy in Board of Education, how filled.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Repeal of former
act

SECTION 1. An act entitled "an act to amend an act in relation to free schools in the town of Minneapolis, approved May 23, 1857," which act was approved March 6th, 1862, is hereby repealed.

Proceedings of
Board of Equal-
lization confirmed

SEC. 2. The proceedings of the Board of Education of Minneapolis, during the year 1862, in filling vacancies in the said Board, are hereby confirmed.

Vacancy how
filled

SEC. 3. In case of a vacancy in the Board of Education of Minneapolis, it shall be filled until the next annual election, by the remaining members of the Board, when, if the vacancy occurs in the first year of the term
