CHAPTER LXII.

An Act to Change the names of certain persons therein mentioned.

SECTION 1. Change of names of certain persons. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the name of Thomas Gilbertson, of Bancroft, Freeborn County, Minnesota, be and the same is hereby changed to Yorkel G. Jonsrud; that the name of Peter Peterson, residing on or in the immediate vicinity of section twenty-nine (29) of Rushford township, Fillmore County, be and the same is hereby changed to Peter Peterson Haslerud.

CHAPTER LXIII.

SECTION 1. Deemed the lawful child of Philo and Charlotte E. Bliss.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That Philo Bliss, and Charlotte E. Bliss,

his wife, of Owatonna, Steele County, Minnesota, shall Lawful held of henceforth, to all intents and purposes, stand in the Philo and Charsame relation respectively towards the deserted child lotte E. Biles they desire to adopt, as they might or would, if he were their issue born in lawful wedlock, and shall be entitled to all the rights and privileges, and subject to all the duties and obligations to which they would be entitled and subject, were said child their lawful issue; and that said child is hereby made the heir-at-law of said Philo and Charlotte E. Bliss, and shall be entitled to all the rights and privileges, and subject to all the duties and obligations to which he would be entitled and subject, if the said Philo Bliss and Charlotte E. Bliss, his wife, were his lawful parents.

SEC. 2. That the name of said child is hereby declar- Name of child ed to be William Luther Bliss, and by said name he

shall be hereafter known and recognized.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
