CHAPTER LXVII.

An Act to Amend "An act granting to John L. Wilson, Antoine Edlebrock, and William A. Corbett, the right to establish and maintain a Ferry across the Mississippi River, at St. Cloud, and for other purposes," passed March 3, 1855, and to extend the Ferry Rights of Antoine Roberts, across the Minnesota River.

- SECTION 1. Amendment to sections six and eight, of act passed March 3, 1855.
6. Maintenance of said ferry—for what length of time.
 8. Rates charged for crossing said ferry.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That Sections 6 and 8, Chapter 62, in an act granting to John L. Wilson, Antoine Edlebrock, and William A. Corbett, the right to establish and maintain a ferry across the Mississippi River, at Saint Cloud, and for other purposes, be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 6. That Antoine Roberts, his heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns, shall have the exclusive right and privilege, for the period of fifteen years, of keeping and maintaining a ferry across the Minnesota River, at the terminus of the Territorial road leading from Saint Paul to Traverse des Sioux, at a point where the said Roberts lives in Le Sueur county; and no other ferry shall be established within one and a half miles of said ferry, either above or below.

Sec. 8. The rates charged for crossing the above ferry, shall not exceed the following:

For each foot passenger, - - - - -	5 cents.	
“ “ horse, mare, mule, or ass, with or without rider, - - - - -	10 “	Rates charged for crossing said ferry
For each two horse or mule team, loaded or unloaded, - - - - -	25 “	
For each single horse and carriage, - - - - -	15 “	
“ “ additional cow or ox, - - - - -	5 “	
“ “ swine or sheep, - - - - -	2 “	

All freights, merchandize, or other articles, not in teams, at the rate of five cents per hundred pounds, and fifty cents per thousand feet of lumber.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXVIII.

An Act Authorizing Katharine F. Fullerton to Sell and Convey certain Real Estate, therein mentioned, as a Femme Sole.

- SECTION 1. Right to sell and convey certain real estate herein mentioned.
 2. Duty of County Treasurer.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That Katharine F. Fullerton, of Somerville, in the County of Middlesex, in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and a married woman, the wife of James Fullerton, be and she is hereby authorized and empowered, to sell and convey by deed, an undivided half part of lots six (6), seven (7), eight (8), and nine (9), in block numbered eighty (80), in the town of Min-
