Joint Resolution Providing for the Protection of the Frontier.

Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

That the Governor of this State be, and is hereby authorized and empowered, to employ such force from the Providing for the militia of the State, as will extend protection and secu-frontier rity to the frontier settlements, and to remove such Indians as the safety of the State may require.
