Joint Resolution Relative to the Ceding of Douglas County, Wisconsin, to the State of Minnesota.

Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

That a Memorial concerning the cession to Minnesota, Relative to the of the County of Douglas, Wisconsin, be forwarded to cading of Douglas, the Legislature of Wisconsin, and that upon the adopcassin, to this tion by the Legislature of the State of Wisconsin of a state resolution or other act, consenting to said cession, the said territory in said Memorial described, shall become part of this State.

NUMBER V.

Joint Resolution of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota, Authorizing Banks to comply with the provisions of the act of Congress to provide a National Currency.

Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

That any bank or banking association authorized by Authorising the laws of this State to engage in the business of bank-banks to complying, and duly organized under such laws as a bank or with the provisbanking association, and being actually engaged in the loss for a nation-business of banking, is hereby authorized to avail itself
