CHAPTER XI.

An Act to amend an act entitled "an act to legalize the action of County Commissioners in appropriating money for bounties to soldiers, and for the support of families of soldiers, and to provide for the levy of taxes to pay county, city and town bounties."

SECTION 1. Legalization and validity of actions of Roards of County Commissioners. 2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one of chapter eight of the extra session laws of the year 1862, be amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1. That the action of the county commissioners of any county or of any city council, or of the Actions of boards board of supervisors of any town in this State, in ap-of county commispropriating money, issuing bonds, orders, scrip, or walls other evidence of indebtedness to pay bounties to soldiers, or to support the families of soldiers, or which may hereafter be appropriated or issued by the authorities hereinbefore mentioned, pursuant to such action

heretofore had, or which have been or may hereafter be appropriated or issued in pursuance of a vote of the electors of any county, city or town, cast at any election heretofore held for that purpose, and any tax which has been or may be levied by any of the authorities specified in this act, for the payment of the principal and interest, or either, of such bonds, orders, scrip or other evidence of indebtedness be, and the same is hereby legalized and made valid, and the payment of the principal and interest thereof, and the levy of such tax shall be binding on such county, city or town, the same as if such action had been authorized by law, and such tax shall be collected in the same manner as other county, city or town taxes are now collected.

CHAPTER XII.

An Act to provide for the assessment of, and levying Taxes upon the Winnebago Trust Lands in the County of Blue Earth, after the sale of such Lands.

- SECTION 1. Appointment of Board of Commissioners to assess said lands.

 - 3. Said lands shall be subject to taxation.
 - 4. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That there shall be appointed by the board of commissioners of Blue Earth county, an assessor, whose duty it shall be to assess for taxation all lands in said county, known as Winnebago trust lands, and which may have been sold by the authority of the United States, to any persons or corporations, before the day fixed by law for the assessment of property in
