## CHAPTER XXVI.

An Act to change the time of holding Court in the county of McLeod.

- SECTION 1. Time of holding general term of District Court in McLeod County.
  - 2. All writs, recognizances, etc., deemed to be returned to such court.
  - 3. Repeal of former act.
  - 4. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the general term of the district runs or holding court in and for the county of McLeod, in the sixth count judicial district, shall be held on the third Monday in

November in each year.

SEC. 2. All writs, recognizances and other proceedings made returnable to said district court, shall be considered and deemed to be returnable to the term of all writs, recognisaid court as fixed by this act, and all continuances and returned to see notices made or taken to any term of said court, shall be deemed to be made or taken to the term of said court as fixed by this act, and all motions and other proceedings noticed to be heard at any regular term of said court, shall be allowed and considered to be noticed for hearing at the regular term of such court as fixed by this act.

SEC. 3. So much of chapter thirty of the session repeal of some laws of 1861, as relates to the county of McLeod, is at hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
