CHAPTER LIV.

An Act to prevent the importation, running at large, and sale of diseased sheep.

SECTION 1. Penalty for permitting diseased sheep to run at large.

Beitenacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That any person being the owner of sheep, or having the same in charge, who shall import or drive into this State, or shall turn out, or suffer to run at large upon any common, highway or unenclosed lands, any sheep having any contagious disease, or who shall sell, let or dispose of any such sheep, knowing the same to be so diseased, without first apprising the purchaser thereof, or person taking them, of such disease, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punished by fine in a sum not less than fifty dollars, nor more than one hundred dollars.

. Sec. 2. Nothing in this act shall be so construed

Penalty for permitting diseased sheep to run at large as to prevent the recovery of damages in civil actions. Nothing to prevent against any person or persons who shall import or demander of drive such diseased sheep into this State, or who shall sell, or allow such diseased sheep to run at large.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

That whenever any railroad company in this State, or any division of any railroad company, shall have completed their organization, pursuant to when enthorized the laws creating said milroad company, or the agree- to file report of orment or agreements under which said division was established, such railroad company or division of such railroad company shall be authorized to file in the office of the Secretary of State of this State, a report of its organization, and also in case of the division of an organization, a copy of the agreement or agreements under which said division was organized.
