An Act to amend an act entitled " an act to authorize the Farmers' Bank of Garden City to dispose of its bank note plate."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. An act entitled an act to authorize the Farmers' Bank of Garden City to dispose of its bank note plate, approved March eleventh, 1861, is hereby amended, so that the said act shall read as follows :

Section 1. It shall be lawful for the Farmers' Bank of Mankato, heretofore located at Mankato, in Blue Earth county, and it is hereby authorized to remove Authorized to reits location, office and fixtures to Shakopee, Scott move its fixtures, county, at any time hereafter, by filing in the office of the register of deeds of the said county of Scott, and of the Auditor of State, a certificate duly signed and acknowledged by the stockholders of said bank, or a majority thereof, before a notary public, that such location, office and fixtures are so removed.

SEC. 2. After the filing of such certificate, according to the provisions of the first section of this act, May harmany do the said bank may lawfully do business at Shakopee, instead of Mankato, and shall be entitled to all the privileges, and subject to all the liabilities conferred or imposed upon any bank or banking association organized under and pursuant to the provision of an act to authorize and regulate the business of banking, approved July 26th, 1858, and the acts amending the same.

SEC. 3. After such removal of said Farmers' Bank of Mankato to Shakopee, as provided in this act. it

Where circulating notes for redamption may be presented

Duty of State Auditor shall be lawful to present its circulating notes for redemption at Shakopee, instead of Mankato, and said presentation at Shakopee shall subject the bank to the same liabilities, if said notes are not redecemed upon presentation, as said bank is now subject to, upon the presentation of said notes at Mankato; but it shall not be lawful for any person to present such circulating notes at Mankato after the removal of said bank to Shakopee, as authorized by this act.

SEC. 4. The State Auditor is hereby authorized, when proof is presented to him, that a banking organization has been established at Shakopee, as contemplated in the first section of this act, and that it has purchased from the Farmers' Bank at Mankato, its interest in the bank note plate, to erase from the plate the word Mankato, and insert the word Shakopee, and thereafter to issue countersigned impressions to the said Farmers' bank at Shakopee, in the same manner and subject to the same restriction as if engraving had been done for it upon his order.

SEO. 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
