## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That it shall be lawful for the legal voters of the town of Waconia, in Carver county, at their next annual town meeting, to determine, by a vote, for or against the assessing of a tax of ten mills on the dollar upon all the taxable property in said town, for the purpose of building roads and bridges, and for paying the indebtedness of said town.

Duties of judges of election.

Sec. 2. The judges of said election shall canvass said votes in the same manner that votes for town officers are canvassed, and the result of said ballot shall

be transmitted to the county auditor by the town clerk of said town, within ten days thereafter.

SEC. 3. If, upon the receipt of the returns from the above-mentioned town, the county auditor shall not of county find that there is a majority in favor of said tax, then of said assessment the auditor shall levy a tax of ten mills on the dollar. upon all the taxable property in said town, and for said services he shall receive a reasonable compensation

SEC. 4. The tax so levied shall be collected by the Taxes as levied treasurer of said county in the manner, as provided by how collected law for the collection of any taxes assessed in said county.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER XXIV.

An Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Steele County to issue bonds.
