

CHAPTER XXX.

An Act to authorize the township of Oshawa, in Nicollet county, to borrow money for the purpose of paying a bounty to soldiers.

SECTION 1. Board of Supervisors authorized to issue bonds—at what rate of interest—for what purpose.

2. Duty of County Auditor.
3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Authorized to issue

SECTION 1, That for the purpose of enabling the township of Oshawa, in the county of Nicollet, to borrow money for the purpose of paying the bounty offered by said town to each volunteer enlisting therefrom in the service of the United States, under the call of the president, the supervisors of said town of Oshawa, are hereby authorized to issue the bonds, orders, or certificates of said town, to a sufficient amount for the purpose, payable in one, two, three and four years, with interest at a rate not exceeding eight per cent. per annum, and to levy such a tax, from time to time, as may be necessary to pay the interest and principal of said bonds, orders or certificates as they become due.

Duty of county
auditor

SEC. 2. The county auditor of said Nicollet county is hereby authorized to recall the duplicate of 1863, from the county treasurer, and extend thereon, the tax levied by said town of Oshawa, for the payment of said bounty, or any portion thereof, and return the same to the treasurer for collection.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
