

CHAPTER XXXIX.

An Act to assess and collect a tax in the town of Munson, Stearns County to purchase a site and build a Schoolhouse in School District Number twenty, and pay the indebtedness of said town.

- SECTION 1. Supervisors to levy a tax—for what purpose.
 2. Duty of Town Clerk.
 3. By whom said tax to be collected.
 4. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Authorized to levy
tax—for what pur-
pose

SECTION 1. The supervisors of the town of Munson shall have power, and it shall be their duty to assess a tax upon all personal property and real estate in said town, in the month of May, A.D., 1864, sufficient to build a schoolhouse in district number twenty, and pay the indebtedness of said town of Munson.

Duty of town clerk

SEC. 2. It shall be the duty of the town clerk to forward to the county auditor of Stearns county, a copy of said assessment, with the per cent. fixed by the said supervisors, which the auditor shall extend upon the tax roll of said town.

By whom tax to be
collected

SEC. 3. The county treasurer shall collect the said tax, and pay it over to the town treasurer, taking his receipt for the same, retaining one per cent. for said collection.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, any other act or law to the contrary notwithstanding.
