

SEC. 2. That the common council of said city be and they are hereby authorized to subscribe the amount of such advance to the capital stock of the branch of the St. Paul and Pacific Railroad from St. Paul to Winona, said stock to be of the paid-in stock of said corporation, and the amount to be so subscribed by said council not to exceed the amount of said advances in aid of said preliminary survey.

May subscribe to the stock in said road—in what amount

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XLVII.

An Act to authorize the town of West St. Paul, in Dakota county, to raise money to pay contractors for work and materials in opening Isabelle street, in said town.

- SECTION 1. Authorized to levy a special tax—in what amount—for what purpose.
 2. Duty of County Auditor.
 3. When act to take effect.

Beit enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the proper officers be instructed and empowered to levy a special tax in the town of West St. Paul, Dakota county, State of Minnesota, to the amount of not exceeding two hundred and seventy-five dollars, or so much thereof as the supervisors of said town may deem necessary to pay in full the indebtedness of said town to certain contractors for work done and materials furnished in opening and grading Isabelle street, in said town; said work and materials having been ordered by a majority of the

legal voters in said town, in town meeting assembled, on the twentieth day of July, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three.

Duty of county
auditor

SEC. 2. The county auditor of Dakota county is hereby directed to extend upon the tax list of said town the above amount, or so much thereof as said supervisors may elect, and the treasurer of said county is hereby directed to collect said special tax in cash.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XLVIII.

An Act authorizing Ramsey County to pay certain damages assessed on opening the Fort street road.

SECTION 1. Board of County Commissioners empowered to pay any balance of damages awarded after deducting benefits assessed.

2. Payment, from what fund to be made.
3. When act to take effect.

SECTION 1. That the board of county commissioners of Ramsey county are hereby empowered to pay and satisfy, if they shall deem it expedient, to the parties who may be entitled thereto, any balance of damages awarded after deducting benefits assessed by the commissioners appointed under the act entitled "an act relative to the Fort street road, in the county of Ramsey," approved March 12th, 1861, upon such property within said county, as lies without the limits of the city of Saint Paul, and without any of the additions to said city, according to the last assessment
