The county officers in Todd and Morrison counties, to whom such returns are made, shall, within twenty days after said election, canvass the votes returned for and against said change of county line, and shall forthwith certify the result of such canvass to the Governor, who, if it appears that a majority of the voters in said counties, voting at said election, are in favor of a change of county line, shall make proclamation thereof, by publishing in a newspaper of Saint Paul, that the change proposed by this act has been ratified by a majority of the voters of Todd and Morrison counties, voting at said election.

more of them named in the first section of said act when and where may open books for the subscription of so much of the books to be opencapital stock of said company as he or they may deem to capital stock proper, at Sauk Rapids, St. Cloud, or St. Paul, at any time within one year from the passage of this act, by giving notice thereof at least four weeks in any newspaper published in Sauk Rapids or St. Cloud; and when the stock in said company has been taken in good faith, to an amount not less than twenty thousand dollars, the proceedings thereafter shall conform in all respects to the provisions of the act to which this is an amendment.

SEC. 2.
