city government, and the payment of its debts and liabilities, including the repairing of sewers, sidewalks, streets and highways, and the same shall be assessed in the manner provided for by the general laws of this State, for the assessment of taxes for town purposes. But said assessment shall not exceed six mills on the dollar of the real valuation, and all qualified voters shall be liable to a poll tax, not exceeding one dollar in any one year, to be levied by the city council. Provided That there shall be set apart each year, of the sum so assessed, at least one mill on the dollar for the payment of the outstanding indebtedness of the city.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXXVI.

An Act to authorize Commissioners to amend the description of the town plat of Florence.

SECTION 1. Commissioners authorized to locate the town of Florence, and to make a true description thereof. 2. When act to take effect.

Beit enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

That Calvin Potter, James Sutherland SECTION 1. and Joseph D. Spinner, or any two of them, are here- Authorized to loby authorized to locate the town plat of Florence, in enterties and to the county of Goodhue, and to make a true descrip- make a true des tion thereof, specifying the legal subdivision of the eriction thereof quarter section, township and range on which said town plat is surveyed and platted. Said description thus 44

made shall be certified upon the oath or affirmation of said commissioners, and placed on file in the office of the register of deeds in said Goodhue county, Minnesota, and such description, so made and filed, shall be attached to the original plat. All deeds heretofore given, or conveyances made, or liens and rights acquired, shall be as valid as though the description of said town plat had been originally so made.

This act shall take effect from and after its SEC. 2. passage.

CHAPTER LXXVII.

An Act to attach part of Davidson's addition to the Village of Austin to that of Morgan's.

SECTION 1. What to constitute Morgan's Addition to said town. 2. Duty of Register of Deeds.

3. When set to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION. 1. All that part of Davidson's addition what to constitute to the village of Austin, Mower county, lying north Morgan's addition of Water street, shall hereafter be known and described as Morgan's addition to the village of Austin.

SEC. 2. The register of deeds of said county is Duty of Regimer of hereby required to note the alteration hereby made Deads upon the record of the plat of said Davidson's addition in his office.

> SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
