made shall be certified upon the oath or affirmation of said commissioners, and placed on file in the office of the register of deeds in said Goodhue county, Minnesota, and such description, so made and filed, shall be attached to the original plat. All deeds heretofore given, or conveyances made, or liens and rights acquired, shall be as valid as though the description of said town plat had been originally so made.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its

passage.

CHAPTER LXXVII.

An Act to attach part of Davidson's addition to the Village of Austin to that of Morgan's.

SECTION 1. What to constitute Morgan's Addition to said town.

2. Duty of Register of Deeds.

3. When set to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section. 1. All that part of Davidson's addition what to constitute to the village of Austin, Mower county, lying north to said town of Water street, shall hereafter be known and described as Morgan's addition to the village of Austin.

SEC. 2. The register of deeds of said county is puty of negtner of hereby required to note the alteration hereby made upon the record of the plat of said Davidson's addition in his office.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
