CHAPTER XIV.

An Act to allow the legal voters of School Districts containing less than ten voters, when lawfully assembled, not less than three being present, to transact certain business.

March 3, 1865.

SECTION 1. Power of legal voters in any school district—limitation to amount of tax.

2. When act to take effect.

Beit enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the legal voters of any school district in this State, containing less than ten voters, power of legal when lawfully assembled, not less than three being voters in any present, shall have power, by a majority of the votes indicated interior of those present, to do, and perform all the acts mentioned in the several sub-divisions of section twenty-six of chapter one of session laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-two: Provided, That such meeting shall not vote a tax to exceed in amount, more than one hundred dollars in any one year.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force

from and after its passage.
