CHAPTER XXVI.

An Act to repeal chapter twenty-nine of general laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-three, and chapter return to 1866, thirty-two of the general laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, relating to indictments and presentments by grand juries, and to restore the provisions of law thereby repealed.

SECTION 1. Repeal of former act—restoration of former act repealed.

2. When set to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That chapter twenty-nine of the general laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, and chapter thirty-two of the general laws Repeal of tomose of the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-four, torner act repealed be and the same are hereby repealed, and sections thirty and thirty-one of chapter one hundred and four of the public statutes of the State of Minnesota, are hereby restored, with the like force and effect as though the same had not been repealed.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
