

CHAPTER LVI.

An Act to amend chapter seventeen of the Compiled Statutes, relating to corporations.

March 1, 1865.

- SECTION 1. To be lawful to dispose of any real estate belonging to any religious incorporation.
 2. Repeal of former act.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section thirty-two of chapter seventeen of the compiled statutes be amended so as to read as follows :

Section 32. It shall be lawful for any religious incorporation organized under the provisions of this chapter, by and through their trustees, to sell and convey, encumber or otherwise dispose of any real estate belonging to such corporation. *Provided, however,* That no such conveyance or encumbrance shall be made by the trustees except when first authorized to make the same by a resolution of such society passed at a meeting thereof called for that purpose, notice of the time, place and object of which meeting shall be given for at least four successive Sabbaths on which such society shall stately meet for public worship, immediately preceding the time specified for such meeting.

Religious incorporations may dispose of real estate belonging to said corporation.

SEC. 2. That section thirty-three, of chapter seventeen, of the compiled statutes, is hereby repealed.

Repeal of former act.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
