*An Act appropriating money for the salaries of the State officers for the year eighteen hundred and sixty-five.*

SECTION 1. Appropriation for salaries of State Officers for the year eighteen hundred and sixty-five.

1. For the salary of Governor.
  2. For the salary of Secretary of State.
  3. For the salary of Auditor of State.
  4. For the salary of Treasurer of State.
  5. For the salary of the Attorney General.
  6. For the salaries of the Judges of the Supreme and District Courts.
  7. For the salary of the Clerk of the Supreme Court.
2. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

Appropriations for salaries of State officers.

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury, belonging to the general revenue fund, and not otherwise appropriated, for the payment of the salaries of the State officers for the year eighteen hundred and sixty-five.

1st. For the salary of the Governor two thousand dollars.

2d. For the salary of the Secretary of State, twelve hundred dollars.

Appropriations for salaries of State officers.

3d. For the salary of the Auditor of State, twelve hundred dollars.

4th. For the salary of the Treasurer of State, one thousand dollars.

5th. For the salary of the Attorney General, one thousand dollars.

6th. For the salaries of the Judges of the Supreme Court and District Courts, eighteen thousand dollars.

7th. For the salary of the Clerk of the Supreme Court, six hundred dollars.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.
