

to the same care, custody and control as if he had been the child of the said Charles G. Tanner and Lucinda Tanner.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER C.

An Act to change the name of Almadora Dustin to that of Almadora Parker.

March 2, 1865.

SECTION 1. Change of name.
 2. Declared legal heir of Benjamin Parker.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the name of Almadora Dustin, Change of name. be, and the same is hereby changed to that of Almadora Parker.

SEC. 2. That the said Almadora Parker is hereby constituted an heir at law of Benjamin Parker and Hannah Parker, his wife, of the town of Richfield, Hennepin county, and she shall enjoy all the rights and privileges, and be subject to the same control, as if she was the legitimate child of the said Benjamin Parker and Hannah Parker. Declared legal heir of Benjamin Parker.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
