CHAPTER XVII.

An Act to amend the Charter of the city of Wabashaw. March 2, 1863.

- SECTION 1. Boundary line of the city of Wabashaw.

 2. When election to be held—election of aldermed—term of office.
 - 3. Disposition of moneys collected for ticenses.
 - 4. Repeal of inconsistent ages.
 - 5. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

[Section 1.] That section two of chapter one of said act be, and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows, viz:

Territory included within the following boundaries and limits shall constitute the city of Wabashaw, viz:

Beginning at a point on the Mississippi river on the dividing line between Wisconsin and Minnesota, at the mouth of a small creek between Wabashaw and Reed's Roundary line of Landing, thence up said creek on the west line of town-the city of Wabaship number one hundred and eleven, north, range ten enaw. west; thence along the said township line to the north east corner of section number thirty-six, township number one hundred and eleven, north, range eleven west; thence along the north line of said section number thirty-six, to the north west corner of said section; thence on the west line of said section to the south west corner; thence on the south line of said section to the south east corner; thence along the west line of section six, township one hundred and ten, north, range ten west, to the south west corner of said section; thence along the south line of sections six, five and four of township one hundred and ten, north, range ten west, to the south east corner of said section number four; thence north along the east line of said section four, township one hundred and ten, north, range ten west, and section thirty-three, township one hundred and eleven, north, range ten west, to the Wisconsin line; [thence along the Wisconsin line | to the place of beginning.

SEC. 2. That section fourteen of chapter seven of said act be, and the same is amended to read as follows:

When election to be held—election of aldermon term of office. At the next general election under this act, to be holden on the first Tuesday of April, A. D. eighteen hundred and sixty-five, there shall be elected three aldermen, one who shall serve for one year, one for two years and one for three years, and thereafter there shall be one alderman elected at each general election, who shall be elected for three years, and until his successor is elected and qualified.

Disposition of moneys collected for licenses.

SEC. 3. All moneys collected for licenses under the provisions of this act or the ordinances of said city, shall be paid into the treasury of said city, for the use of common schools in said city.

Sec. 4. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with

this act, are hereby repealed.

Sec. 5. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XVIII.

March 2, 1865.

An Act to amend chapter ten of the special laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, entitled "an act relating to the town of Minneapolis."

SECTION 1. Provisions for the construction and maintenance of sidewalks—how expense of provided for—bo designate fire limits—penalty for violation of provisions of subdivision—to purchase fire angine and other fire apparatus.

2. To levy tax to carry out the provisions of this act.

3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Section one of said chapter ten of the
