<u>_Mint 3, 1888.</u> An Act to vacate certain streets and alleys in the city of Rochester.

Section 2. Vecation of certain portion of Ninth street.

2. Vacation of the alley running north and south in block twenty-one.

Vacation of all the alleys in block twenty-six.

4. When act to take effect.

Beitenacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Vacation of cortain portion of Winth street.

Vacation of the allay in block twenty-one.

Vacation of all the sileys in block twenty-six.

SECTION 1. All that portion of Ninth street lying between Broadway and Franklin street in the village now city of Rochester, county of Olmsted, be and the same is hereby vacated, and may be occupied for railroad and depot purposes.

SEC. 2. All that portion of the alley running north and south in block twenty-one in the original plat of the village, now city, of Rochester, in the county of Olmsted, be and the same is hereby vacated.

SEC. 3. All the several alleys in block twenty-six in Head & McMahon's addition to the village, now city, of Rochester, county of Olmsted, be and the same is hereby vacated.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
