

CHAPTER XXVII.

An Act to vacate a portion of the recorded plot of the town of Franconia. March 2, 1865.

SECTION 1. Vacation of certain portions of said town.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That all that part of the recorded plot of the town of Franconia, in the county of Chisago, as surveyed by Henry H. Newbery, included in block number nineteen, and so much of Francis street as lies adjoining said block, is hereby vacated^{Vacation of certain portions of said town.}.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XXVIII.

An Act in relation to Free Schools in the town of Minneapolis. March 2, 1865.

SECTION 1. Boundaries of school districts—public schools to be under the control of the Board of Education.
2. Number of school directors to be chosen at next annual election—term of office.

4. Powers of Board of Education.
