

CHAPTER LXXI.

An Act in relation to the county tax in Ramsey county.

March 2, 1865.

- SECTION 1. Duty of Board of County Commissioners.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the board of county commissioners of Ramsey county are authorized to fix the amount of tax to be levied for county purposes in said county, under the general laws of this State, at not exceeding four mills on the dollar of taxable property in said county, in any one year.

Duty of board of county commissioners.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER LXXII.

An Act to annex a portion of the township of Ottawa to the township of Le Sueur.

March 2, 1865.

- SECTION 1. Portion of said town attached to Le Sueur—for what purpose.
2. To be submitted to the voters of said town.
3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That sections number one and two,

Portion of said town attached to LeSueur—for what purpose.

and lots number one and two, in section three, lot three in section ten, lot one and the northeast quarter and the east half of the northwest quarter and the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section eleven, and the north half of section twelve, all in township number one hundred and eleven north, of range twenty-six, west, in the township of Ottawa, in the county of Le Sueur, are hereby detached from the township of Ottawa and attached to the township of Le Sueur, for all purposes whatsoever: *Provided however*, That any taxes now due on said lands, assessed for town purposes, shall be paid to the said township of Ottawa.

To be submitted to the voters of said towns.

SEC. 2. This act shall be submitted to the action of the people of said townships of Le Sueur and Ottawa for their approval or rejection at the next election after the passage of this act, at which said election the electors shall vote by ballot; either written, printed, or part written and part printed as follows: "For annexation to Le Sueur," or "Against annexation to Le Sueur." Said ballots shall be canvassed the same as other ballots, and if it shall appear on canvassing said votes that a majority of all the votes cast in both townships are in favor of the annexation, then this act shall be in full force and effect; otherwise to be of no effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
