

CHAPTER XCIII.

February 25, 1865. *An Act to change the name of O. F. C. Makril to that of O. F. C. Tolberg, and the name of Gustaf Johnson to that of Gustaf Hultquist.*

SECTION 1. Change of names of persons herein mentioned.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Change of names
of persons herein
mentioned.

SECTION 1. That the name of O. F. C. Makril, residing on section thirteen, township thirty-four north, of range twenty west, in the county of Chisago, be and the same is hereby changed to that of O. F. C. Tolberg; and the name of Gustaf Johnson, residing on section thirty-two, township thirty-four north, of range twenty west, in the county of Chisago, be and the same is hereby changed to that of Gustaf Hultquist.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XCIV.

March 1, 1865. *An Act to change the name of James M. Turpin to that of James M. Nichols, and the name of William Edward Parker to that of William Edward Hulbert.*

SECTION 1. Change of names.
2. Declared the lawful heirs of Walter E. Nichols and Chas. S. Hulbert.
3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the name of James M. Turpin be,

and the same is hereby changed to that of James M. Nichols, and the name of William Edward Parker be, and the same is hereby changed to that of William Edward Hulbert. Change of names.

SEC. 2. The said James M. Nichols and William Edward Hulbert are hereby declared to be the legal heirs at law respectively, to wit: James M. Nichols of Walter E. Nichols and Mary E. Nichols, his wife; and William Edward Hulbert of Chas. S. Hulbert and Julia J. Hulbert, his wife, of the county of Rice and State of Minnesota; and they shall enjoy all the rights and privileges and be subject to the same care and guardianship as if they had been the respective sons of the said Walter E. Nichols and Chas. S. Hulbert, born in lawful wedlock. Declared lawful heirs of Walter E. Nichols and Chas. S. Hulbert.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XCV.

An Act to change the name of Kate Brady to that of Kate Warner. March 1, 1865.

- SECTION 1. Change of name.
 2. Declared the lawful heir of Merritt Warner.
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the name of Kate Brady be and the same is hereby changed to that of Kate Warner. Change of name.

SEC. 2. That the said Kate Warner is hereby declared to be the daughter and heir-at-law of Merritt Warner and Ursula Warner, of the town of Spring Val-
