

## CHAPTER XLIV.

*An Act to define the boundary line of Pope County  
and to provide for its organization.* February 28, 1866

**SECTION 1.** Establishes the boundary line of Pope County.

2. Locates the county seat.
3. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

**SECTION 1.** The boundary line of Pope county is hereby established, and shall hereafter be as follows : Boundary of Pope county.  
Beginning at the north-east corner of township one hundred and twenty six (126) north, of range thirty-six (36) west of fifth principal meridian, thence west to the north-west corner of township one hundred and twenty-six (126) north, of range forty (40) west; thence south to the south-west corner of township one hundred and twenty-three (123) north, of range forty (40) west; thence east to the south-east corner of township one hundred and twenty-three (123) north, of range thirty-six (36) west; thence north to the place of beginning.

**SEC. 2.** The county of Pope is hereby declared an organized county, and the county seat thereof temporarily located at the town of Stockholm, situated upon the north half of the south-east quarter of section No. eighteen (18), in township one hundred and twenty-three (123) north, of range thirty-seven (37) west. Temporarily locates county seat

**SEC. 3.** This act shall be in force from and after its passage.
